How to Choose the Right Mask Size



Find your Full Face or Half Mask Street



STEP 1: GET READY

You'll need a ruler or tape measure. Asking a friend to assist can help ensure accuracy.




STEP 2: MEASURE

Measure Your Face Width:

Place the start of the tape measure at the very center point of your closed mouth (imagine a vertical line down the middle of your face).

Measure horizontally in a straight line past the outer corner of your mouth.

Stop measuring at a point that is at least 1 inch (2.5 cm) beyond the corner of your mouth. Note this measurement.





STEP 3: CALCULATE

Calculate Your Size Number:

Take the measurement you just noted (at the end of Step 2) and multiply it by 2 (double it).

STEP 4: FIND YOUR SIZE

Find Your Mask Size:

Compare your calculated size number (from Step 3) to the guide below. Choose the size that matches most closely.

LARGE: Matches a measurement of 5 inches (12.7 cm)

MEDIUM: Matches a measurement of 4.5 inches (11.4 cm)

SMALL: Matches a measurement of 4 inches (10.2 cm)
